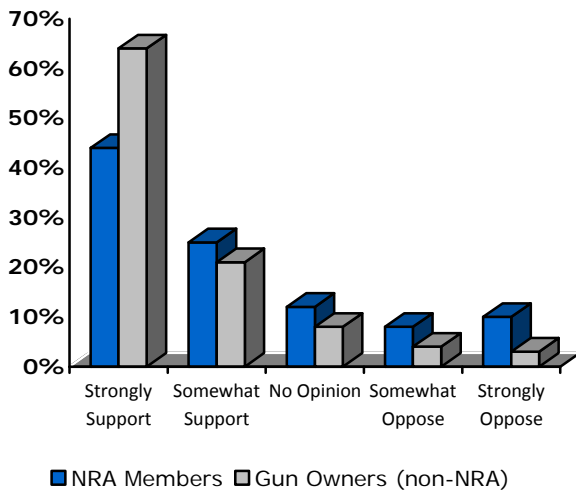


**Gun Owners, NRA Members, and Common Sense Gun Laws:
 2009 Illinois and National Polling Results**

FACT: In Illinois and nationwide, both gun owners and NRA members overwhelmingly support extending background checks for gun sales.

Nationwide



Nationwide, an overwhelming majority of NRA members and gun owners support requiring gun sellers at gun shows to conduct background checks on people buying guns.

More than two thirds (69%) of NRA members support background checks at gun shows, with 44% strongly supporting.

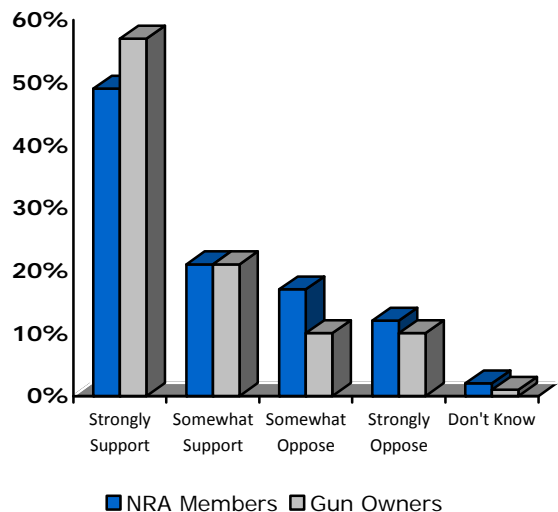
85% of gun owners support such a proposal, with 64% strongly supporting background checks at gun shows.

In Illinois, where background checks are required at gun shows, an overwhelming majority of NRA members and gun owners support requiring every gun owner to undergo a background check, whether their gun is bought from a licensed gun dealer or a private seller.

More than two thirds (70%) of NRA members support background checks for all gun sales, with 49% strongly supporting.

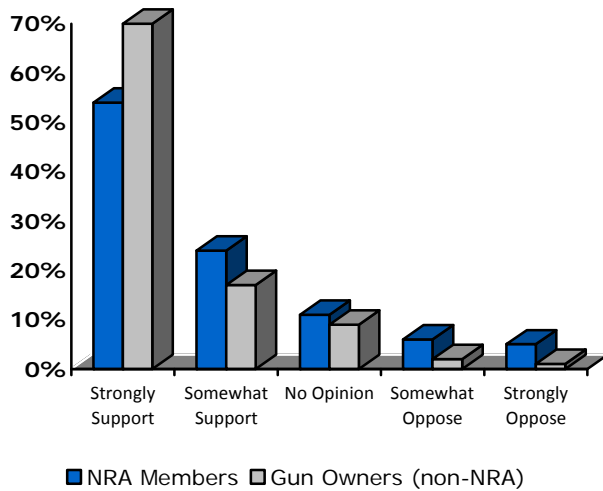
79% of gun owners support such a proposal, with 57% strongly supporting.

Illinois



FACT: Both nationally and in Illinois, gun owners and NRA members overwhelmingly support requiring gun owners to report lost or stolen firearms to law enforcement.

Nationwide



Nationwide, an overwhelming majority of NRA members and gun owners support requiring gun owners to alert police if their guns are lost or stolen.

78% of NRA members support required loss or theft reporting, with more than half (54%) strongly supporting.

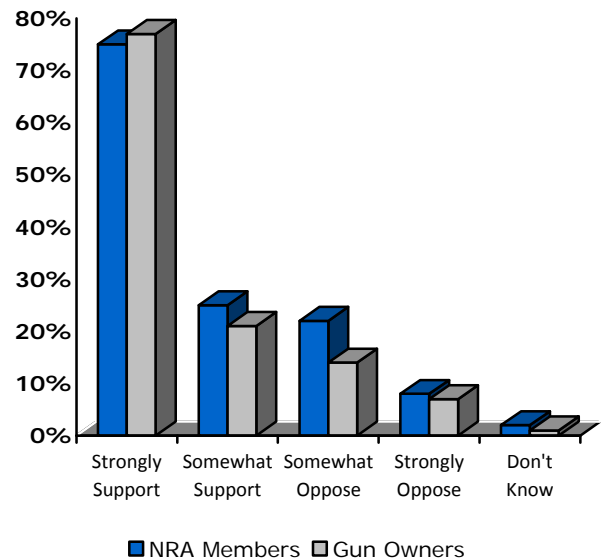
88% of gun owners support such a proposal, with 70% strongly supporting.

In Illinois, an overwhelming majority of NRA members and gun owners support requiring gun owners to inform law enforcement if their guns are lost or stolen.

Nine in ten (90%) of NRA members support required loss or theft reporting, with 75% strongly supporting.

91% of gun owners support such a proposal, with 77% strongly supporting.
