ACEVEDO ASSAULT WEAPONS BAN PASSES HOUSE PANEL

SPRINGFIELD, IL— Last Wednesday State Rep. Eddie Acevedo (D-Chicago) passed legislation out of the House Executive Committee that would create a broad assault weapons ban for Illinois. “This legislation will make our communities and children safer,” Rep. Acevedo said. “It will enhance security for those in law enforcement who put their lives in jeopardy to keep predators off of our streets.”
